STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Increase the Salary of the Secretary of State.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section fifteen, of chapter one hundred and seventeen of

- 2 the revised statutes, as amended by chapter two hundred
- 3 and twelve of the public laws of nineteen hundred and
- 4 twenty-one, is hereby further amended by striking out the
- 5 words "thirty-five hundred," in the second line thereof, and
- 6 by inserting in lieu thereof the words, 'four thousand'; and
- 7 by striking out the words "beginning January first, nineteen
- 8 hundred and twenty-one," in the third line thereof, so that
- 9 said section, as amended, shall read as follows:

'Sect. 15. The secretary of state shall receive an annual 2 salary of four thousand dollars. He and his deputy shall

3 also receive such actual travelling expenses incident to the 4 administration of his department as shall be necessary.

The number and compensation of clerks employed by the 2 secretary of state shall be determined by the governor and council.'
