STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Skowhegan.

Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated the
2 sum of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) to aid the
3 town of Skowhegan in the construction of a bridge across
4 the Kennebec river, at some point below the existing rail-
5 road bridge.

This bridge shall be constructed under the provisions of
2 the Bridge Act, so called, and construction work shall be
3 started in the year nineteen hundred twenty-seven.
