STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, Providing for Erection of Equestrian Statue at
Gettysburg in Memory of Maj. Gen. Oliver Otis Howard.

Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated the
2 sum of fifty thousand (\$50,000) for the purchase and erec-
3 tion of an appropriate equestrian statue to be erected in the
4 Gettysburg National Park at Gettysburg, Pennsylvania, as
5 a monument to the memory of Major General Oliver Otis
6 Howard, a general in the United States Army from the
7 State of Maine and who rendered distinguished service on
8 that field.

Resolved Further: That the Governor is hereby author-

2 ized and directed, upon the approval of this resolve, to ap-
3 point a commission of three persons to serve without pay,
4 who are hereby authorized and directed to make all neces-
5 sary contracts and arrangements for the building and erec-
6 tion of the statue. All the necessary expenses of the com-
7 mission appointed under the provisions of this resolve inci-
8 dent to the carrying out of the provisions of this resolve
9 shall be paid from the sum hereby appropriated.
