STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE; in Favor of C. J. Thomas, Compensating Him for
the Loss of a Cow.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the
2 sum of two hundred and fifty dollars to be paid to C. J.
3 Thomas to compensate him for a cow which was con-
4 demned and killed by the state for alleged tuberculosis.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This cow was purchased in Canada and legally transported into Maine. Several tuberculin tests were made and in one only was there a reaction, however, she was condemned by Doctor Corliss and taken from Mr. Thomas. Mr. Thomas executed a claim voucher in the sum of two hundred fifty dollars for damages sustained by her loss which are unpaid.
