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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

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RESOLVE, in Favor of Raymond E. Hurd, Compensating  
Him for Injuries.

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Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated  
2 the sum of one thousand dollars to be paid to Earl R.  
3 Hurd of Sebec, Maine, for the benefit of his son, Raymond  
4 E. Hurd to compensate said Raymond E. Hurd for injuries  
5 sustained by the explosion of a dynamite battery cap left  
6 in the highway by workmen on the state highway leading  
7 from Milo to Dover-Foxcroft.

## STATEMENT OF FACTS

Raymond E. Hurd, a scholar in a country school was playing beside the road on October ninth, nineteen hundred and twenty-eight and found a dynamite battery cap which had been negligently left by workmen of the state highway; not knowing the power of the cap, he attached it to a battery when it exploded causing the loss of the first phalange of the second and third fingers of his left hand.
