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STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

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AN ACT Providing for the Retirement of Court Stenographers,  
and Their Compensation.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter two hundred and fifty-three of the  
2 public laws of nineteen hundred and twenty-seven is hereby  
3 repealed.

Sect. 2. Stenographers of the supreme judicial and supe-  
2 rior courts, after having served twenty-five years in either  
3 or both courts, and having reached the age of sixty-five  
4 years, may retire and shall receive for the remainder of  
5 their lives annual compensation, divided into monthly pay-  
6 ments, equivalent to three-quarters of the salary paid  
7 stenographers for active service in such courts.
