STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Amend the Charter of the Bar Harbor Village
Improvement Association.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter one hundred eighty-six of the private and special
2 laws of the year eighteen hundred ninety-one is hereby
3 amended by striking out section two of said act and insert-
4 ing in the place thereof the following section to receive the
5 same number.

‘Sect. 2. For the purposes of its incorporation this Asso-
2 ciation may receive and hold real and personal property not
3 exceeding two hundred fifty thousand (\$250,000) dollars
4 in amount; make contracts binding upon itself but not upon

5 its individual members; and to make by-laws not incon-
6 sistent with law for the regulation of its membership and
7 its government. The treasurer of this corporation shall
8 make an annual written report showing the financial trans-
9 actions for the prior year and also showing the financial
10 condition of the corporation including an inventory of all
11 its properties. Such report shall be audited by the governor
12 of the state of Maine, or by some suitable person to be
13 appointed by him, and a resume of the same published in
14 any newspaper printed at Bar Harbor.'
