IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Inventory of Exempt Live Stock and  
Fowl.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section sixteen of chapter nine of the revised statutes, as  
2 amended by chapter two hundred eighty-five of the public  
3 laws of nineteen hundred seventeen, as amended by chapter  
4 one hundred eighty-two of the public laws of nineteen hun-  
5 dred twenty-three, is hereby further amended by striking  
6 out in the fifth and following lines and after the word  
7 separately, the following: "and at every fifth year after  
8 nineteen hundred and eighteen the number and value of

9 each kind of domestic fowl. They shall make return there-  
10 of to the state assessors, who shall tabulate the returns and  
11 publish them in detail," so that said section shall read as  
12 amended as follows: 'Assessors of taxes shall include in  
13 the inventory, required to be taken on April first, the num-  
14 ber and value of all neat cattle, eighteen months old and un-  
15 der, all sheep to the number of thirty-five, swine to the  
16 number of ten, and domestic fowl to the number of fifty,  
17 stated separately. Said property shall not be included in  
18 the tax list.'
