IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Provide for the Designation of the Ballot to be
Printed on Both Sides When Folded.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

All ballots furnished to any municipality by the secretary of state, as required by law for use at any state or primary election shall be printed upon the outside so that the designation of the ballot, the polling place for which the ballot is prepared, the date of the election and the facsimile of the secretary of the state shall appear on both sides of the folded ballot.
