STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, to Reimburse the Town of Harmony for Support of Daniel Cookson, a Person Having No Known Settlement in the State.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated to 2 be paid to the town of Harmony, the sum of one hundred 3 dollars and fifty-six cents, to reimburse said town for money 4 expended for support of Daniel Cookson, a person having 5 no known settlement in the state.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This resolve covers the amount paid by the town of Harmony for food supplies, clothing and burial expenses of the pauper. He was a woodsman and river driver during the greater part of his life, and the Selectmen of Harmony have never been able to find that he had a settlement anywhere. He left a sister, Mrs. John Larrabee, but she could not give any information of importance in the matter.
