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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

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RESOLVE, to Reimburse the Town of Harmony for Support  
of Daniel Cookson, a Person Having No Known Settlement  
in the State.

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Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated to  
2 be paid to the town of Harmony, the sum of one hundred  
3 dollars and fifty-six cents, to reimburse said town for money  
4 expended for support of Daniel Cookson, a person having  
5 no known settlement in the state.

## STATEMENT OF FACTS

This resolve covers the amount paid by the town of Harmony for food supplies, clothing and burial expenses of the pauper. He was a woodsman and river driver during the greater part of his life, and the Selectmen of Harmony have never been able to find that he had a settlement anywhere. He left a sister, Mrs. John Larrabee, but she could not give any information of importance in the matter.
