STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, to Improve the Road at Fort William Henry

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, to

- 2 repair and improve the present travelled way extending
- 3 from the main road at Pemaquid Point to Fort William
- 4 Henry in Bristol, Maine, the sum of one thousand dollars,
- 5 the same to be expended under the direction of the gov-
- 6 ernor and council.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Fort William Henry is a historic spot in Maine to which many citizens of Maine and of other states go each year; they reach the fort by the use of a right-of-way which by reason of much travel is very much in need of repair; by reason of its historic interest many more people would visit Fort William Henry if a good road is provided.
