IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, in Favor of M. E. Grumley, M. D., of Millinocket, for Medical Attendance Rendered State Paupers.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the 2 sum of sixty dollars, to be paid to M. E. Grumley, M. D., 3 of Millinocket, for medical attendance to the family of 4 William Burby, state paupers.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

William Burby and family have been assisted as state paupers for several years. Their home was at Grindstone and they have been cared for under the direction of the Selectmen of Millinocket. Dr. Grumley was not aware of the fact that the family were state paupers when he rendered the services for which he asks payment under this resolve. This family was moved to Millinocket last fall, in order to save expense for medical attendance.
