STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE in Favor of Daniel M. Maher for Moving Picture
Films of Governor Parkhurst's Inaugural and Funeral
Services.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated to
2 be paid Daniel M. Maher of Bangor, the sum of four hun-
3 dred dollars for moving picture films of the Governor
4 Parkhurst inaugural and funeral services in 1921.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Daniel M. Maher, a moving picture operator of Bangor was engaged by Gilbert R. Chadbourne, Secretary to Governor Parkhurst in 1921 to take pictures of the inaugural and funeral services. The pictures were taken and the films are now in the possession of Mr. Maher. The bill was never paid as it was claimed that there was not enough money in the contingent fund for the purpose.
