Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the 2 sum of eighty-eight dollars and twenty-five cents to be paid 3 to Adam Manniste of Orneville, Maine, to compensate said 4 Adam Manniste for damages sustained in an accident with

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Manniste was proceeding with an automobile, November nineteenth, nineteen hundred twenty-seven, from Orneville to Milo and descending a hill, a deer jumped directly in front of his car and then swung about so that the car hit the deer and caused the damages to his car to the amount of eighty-eight dollars and twenty-five cents; as the ditches on each side of the road were very deep and the road narrow, it was impossible to avoid the deer.
