STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Empower the Treasurer of Kennebec County to
Pay an Additional Compensation to the Recorder of Gardiner Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The treasurer of the county of Kennebec, is hereby authorized, empowered and directed to pay to Oliver B. Clason of Gardiner, the sum of six hundred dollars for additional services as recorder of the Gardiner municipal court for the period from May thirty-one, nineteen hundred twenty-eight to December fourth, nineteen hundred twenty-eight.
