RESOLVE, in Favor of Payment for Domestic Animal
Killed by Hunter.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the
2 sum of one hundred and fifty dollars, to be paid Eldred
3 Cunningham, of Newcastle, Lincoln county, for his horse
4 shot by hunter.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Eldred Cunningham is a farmer living in that part of the town of Newcastle known as Sheepscot. In November, last, he was at work in his wood lot and left his horse some distance away. When he returned to the place, the horse had been down, but had gotten to his feet again, and lived until the next day. An examination of the carcass disclosed that the animal had been shot. A fair valuation was one hundred and fifty dollars.
