STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Enfield.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated to
2 be paid to the town of Enfield, for reimbursement for
3 money expended in planking the bridge known as the "How-
4 land Bridge" which connects the towns of Howland and
5 Enfield, the sum of eighteen hundred dollars, the money to
6 come from state highway funds.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This work was done as an emergency in order to insure safety to the traveling public and especially to insure safety to the extra heavy traffic sustained by reason of the heavy trucks which pass over it.

In view of the fact that this bridge is of greater importance and convenience to the town of Howland and to the public at large, Enfield feels that it should have this aid from the state.
