STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Provide for a Two Year Close Time on Ruffed Grouse.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Notwithstanding the provision of section fifty-five of chap-2 ter thirty-three of the revised statutes as amended, there 3 shall be a close season for ruffed grouse, commonly called 4 partridge, for a term of two years commencing on the first 5 day of October, nineteen hundred twenty-nine. Whoever 6 hunts, chases, catches, kills, destroys or has in his posses-7 sion at any time during said period any ruffed grouse or 8 partridge shall pay a fine of not less than ten dollars nor

9 more than fifty dollars and costs for each offense and in

10 addition thereto shall pay five dollars for each ruffed grouse 11 or partridge taken, caught, killed or had in his possession in 12 violation hereof.
