STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Permit Fishing for Pickerel Through the Ice in
Little Sebago Lake in Cumberland County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be lawful to fish through the ice of
2 Little Sebago lake in Cumberland county for pickerel, in
3 the day time, with not more than five set lines for each
4 family when under the immediate personal supervision of
5 the person fishing.

Sect. 2. So much of the provisions of section eighteen
2 of chapter thirty-three or any other provisions of the re-
3 vised statutes as amended as is inconsistent with the above
4 is hereby repealed.
