STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Catching Trout in South Branch Stream, so Called.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

It shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch or kill any trout

- 2 in that part of Great Works stream called "South Branch,"
- 3 the same extending from the junction of Goodwin brook
- 4 and Bradbury brook to the Forks, so called, except from
- 5 the time the ice is out of said South Branch stream until
- 6 the fifteenth day of August following, but this does not
- 7 affect any other part of Great Works stream.
