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## STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

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AN ACT to amend Section 1 of Chapter 7, of the Private and Special Laws of 1921 entitled, "An Act Creating the West Paris Village Corporation," increasing the territory embraced within said corporation.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- The territorial boundaries of the West Paris Village Corporation are hereby increased so as to add the following territory situated in the Town of Paris on the southernly side of the limits of said Corporation as defined in the original act, viz: that part of lots numbered twenty-eight in the first and second ranges in the Town of Paris which is bounded as follows, viz: Northerly by the lot line

8 between lots numbered twenty-eight and twenty-nine; wes-  
9 terly and southwesterly by a line parallel with the Green-  
10 wood road as it in now travelled, the old discontinued  
11 Greenwood road, and High street, this line to be southerly  
12 from and five hundred feet distant from the southerly side  
13 line of said Greenwood road, the old Greenwood road and  
14 High street, and on all other sides by the limits of said  
15 Village Corporation as set forth in the original Act.
