STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Exeter for Compensation for Disbursements.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, to
2 be paid to the town of Exeter, for compensation for sup-
3 plies furnished for Mrs. Bessie Tyler, the sum of thirty-
4 two dollars and fifty cents.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This party came to Exeter and lived a short time there. She fell into distress; she claimed Bangor as her pauper settlement and gave an affidavit to that effect which the town found was false. Before they had time to fully investigate, she had gone. She claimed the man with whom she lived with was her husband. It is not yet ascertained if such is a fact.
