AN ACT Relating to Fly Fishing in Katahdin Lake.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch or  
2 kill any kind of fish, at any time, in Katahdin Lake, in  
3 township three, range eight, W. E. L. S., except in the ordi-  
4 nary manner of casting with unbaited, artificial flies, or fly  
5 fishing, so called; it shall also be unlawful for any person  
6 to take, catch and kill, in any one day more than ten fish in  
7 all, all of which shall be at least eight inches in length, in  
8 said lake or having possession, in any one day more than  
9 ten fish in all, so taken in said waters.
