STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Fly Fishing in Katahdin Lake.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch or

kill any kind of fish, at any time, in Katahdin Lake, in

township three, range eight, W. E. L. S., except in the ordi
nary manner of casting with unbaited, artificial flies, or fly

fishing, so called; it shall also be unlawful for any person

to take, catch and kill, in any one day more than ten fish in

all, all of which shall be at least eight inches in length, in

said lake or having possession, in any one day more than

ten fish in all, so taken in said waters.
