# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Regulate Fishing in Clearwater Pond.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section I. It shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch or

kill any kind of fish at any time in Clearwater Pond situat
ded in the towns of Industry and Farmington in the county

franklin, except by trolling or by fly fishing in the ordi
nary manner; provided, however, that plug fishing, so
called, from permanent wharf or shore with line not ex
ceeding twenty feet in length shall be legal from June first

of each year until September thirtieth following of each

year, both days inclusive.
