STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Henry W. Sagent, Compensating Him for Damages.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the 2 sum of five hundred dollars, to be paid to Henry W. Sagent 3 of Sedgwick to compensate him for land taken for a county 4 road and for damages sustained to his property by reason 5 of the construction of a breakwater on Eggemoggin Reach 6 in the town of Sedgwick.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

A part of the land of Mr. Sagent was taken by the county commissioners of Hancock county for a county road as authorized by chapter seventy-three of the public laws of nineteen hundred twenty-five; no damages were paid him. Also a breakwater was erected and by reason of the change of the course of the sea the action of the water washed over his bank so that he had to erect a retaining wall at considerable expense.
