STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Provide for the Support of the University of
Maine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. A tax of one mill on a dollar shall annually
2 be assessed upon all the property in the state according to
3 the valuation thereof and shall be known as the mill tax
4 for the support of the University of Maine.

Sect. 2. This tax shall be assessed and collected in the
2 same manner as other state taxes and be paid into the state
3 treasury and designated as the University of Maine fund.

Sect. 3. This fund shall be disbursed by the state treas-
2 urer upon proper order of the trustees of the University of

3 Maine upon requisition approved by the governor and coun-
4 cil. This fund shall be in lieu of all other state support,
5 except trust funds held by the state for the benefit of the
6 university and from said fund the trustees shall provide for
7 the necessary buildings, equipment and maintenance of all
8 departments of the university. From said fund shall also be
9 paid such moneys as may be necessary to meet federal re-
10 quirements in connection with said university.
