STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Regulating the Supervision of Public Dances.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Whoever shall conduct a public dance or place of amuse-2 ment where dancing is permitted, except under the super-3 vision of an officer of the law who shall be in attendance 4 at all times during said dance, shall be punished by a fine

5 not exceeding fifty dollars.
