### STATE OF MAINE

# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Mutual Insurance Risks.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section I. Section thirty-three of chapter fifty-three of
2 revised statutes is hereby amended by striking out after the
3 word "property" in the third line thereof the following, "the
4 contents of any building within the state," so that as
5 amended said shall read as follows:

'Domestic Mutual Fire Insurance Companies may make 2 insurance for a term, not exceeding seven years, on dwell-3 ing houses, stores, shops, and other buildings, and on house-4 hold furniture, merchandise and other property, against loss

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5 or damage by fire originating in any cause other than by6 design on the part of the assured.'
