STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Regulating the Catching of Smelts in the Waters of Casco Bay and Mouth of the Presumpscot River in Cumberland County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section I. It shall be unlawful for any person at any time
2 to catch smelts in the waters of Casco Bay and the mouth
3 of the Presumpscot River adjacent to the city of Portland
4 and the town of Falmouth in Cumberland county above
5 and to the north of Martin's Point bridge, so-called, except
6 by the ordinary method of hook and line.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates the provisions of this act shall 2 be liable to a fine of not more than fifty dollars for each 3 offense upon conviction.
