STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to the Lobster Industry Within Two Miles
of the Shore of Monhegan Island.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1 of chapter sixty-one of the private and special
2 laws of nineteen hundred and seven as amended by section
3 one of chapter two hundred ten of the private and special
4 laws of nineteen hundred and nine is hereby amended by
5 striking out from said section the words "twenty-fifth day
6 of June of each year and the fifteenth of January follow-
7 ing" and inserting in lieu thereof the following: 'twenty-
8 fifth day of June of each year and the first day of Decem-

9 ber following,' so that said section when amended shall read
10 as follows:

 'Section 1. It shall be unlawful to take, catch, kill, de-
2 stroy or set any lobster trap or other device for the purpose
3 of taking, catching, killing or destroying any lobster or lob-
4 sters within two miles of the shore of Monhegan Island
5 between the twenty-fifth day of June of each year and the
6 first day of December following.'
