RESOLVE, in Favor of Levi H. May of Island Falls for
Reimbursement to Him for Damage Done His Sheep by
Dogs or Wild Animals.

Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated to
2 be paid to Levi H. May of Island Falls, to reimburse him
3 for damage done his sheep by dogs or wild animals, the sum
4 of thirteen hundred dollars.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

On September 24, 1928, at a referee's hearing on a claim presented by Levi H. May for damages incurred through the loss of sixty-seven sheep and lambs, an award of damages was made to the amount of thirteen hundred dollars. This amount has never been paid by the town of Island Falls as there is a grave question as to the adequacy of the procedure leading to the hearing. There is no dispute as to the amount but Mr. May is following the provisions provided by law in such cases and is asking the state directly for reimbursement.
