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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

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AN ACT to Regulate Fishing in the Brooks and Streams in  
Androscoggin County.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. There shall be an annual closed season on all  
2 the brooks and streams in Androscoggin county, on land-  
3 locked salmon, trout and togue, from July first of each year  
4 to the time the ice is out of the brook or stream fished in  
5 the following spring. It shall be unlawful for any person  
6 to have in possession at any time any landlocked salmon,  
7 trout, or togue, taken in violation of this act.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any provision of this act shall

2 be subject to a fine of not less than ten dollars nor more  
3 thirty dollars and costs of prosecution for each offense, and  
4 in addition thereto one dollar for each fish, or pound of  
5 fish, taken, caught, killed, or had in possession in violation  
6 of any provision of this act.
