STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Establishing Moosehead Lake Game Preserve, in
the County of Piscataquis.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. No person shall at any time hunt, chase, catch,
2 kill or destroy any wild bird or wild animal within the lim-
3 its of the following described tracts, or territory situated
4 in Piscataquis county, to wit: Moose Island and Farm
5 Island, in Moosehead Lake, and the territory bounded as
6 follows: Beginning on the shore of Moosehead Lake at a
7 point nearest to the easterly end of the state road leading
8 westerly from Greenville Junction, so-called, to the state

9 fish hatchery on Squaw brook, thence westerly by said
10 state road to said hatchery, thence northeasterly down said
11 brook to the shore of Moosehead Lake, thence by the shore
12 of said lake to point of beginning.

It shall be unlawful for any person to have in possession
2 at any time any wild bird or wild animal, or part thereof,
3 taken within the above described territory.

Sect. 2. Penalties. Whoever violates any provision of
2 this act shall be subject to a penalty of not less than ten dol-
3 lars nor more than three hundred dollars and costs for each
4 offense, or imprisonment for sixty days, or both said fine
5 and imprisonment.
