STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Close to all Fishing Little River and its
Tributaries.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

It shall be unlawful to fish for, take catch or kill
2 any kind of fish at any time in Little river or any of its
3 tributaries, in the town of Cornish, county of York, except-
4 ing that part of said river from the Trafton bridge, so-
5 called, to its confluence with the Saco river.
