STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Relative to the Regulations of Fees and Costs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section four of chapter one hundred eighteen of the re-

- 2 vised statutes is hereby amended by striking out, in line
- 3 four thereof, the words "four cents" and inserting in place
- 4 of said words the following: 'ten cents,' and by striking out
- 5 in lines five and six thereof the words "eight cents," and in-
- 6 serting in place thereof the following: 'fifteen cents,' and
- 7 by striking out in line twenty-two thereof the words
- 8 "twenty-five cents," and inserting in place thereof the fol-
- 9 lowing: 'fifty cents,' so that said section as amended, shall
- 10 read as follows:

In the fourth line thereof: 'For every blank writ of at-2 tachment with a summons, or of scire facias, or an original 3 summons, ten cents.'

In the fifth and sixth lines thereof: 'Blank writ of replevin 2 with the seal, signature and blank bond, fifteen cents.'

In the twenty-second line thereof: 'Authenticating the of-2 ficial signature of a magistrate, fifty cents.'
