STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Marriage Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. No ceremony of marriage shall be performed

- 2 upon a certificate required by sections four, five and six of
- 3 chapter sixty-four of the revised statutes, more than six
- 4 months after its issue.

Sect. 2. Whoever having taken out such certificate and

- 2 not having used it fails to return it within six months after
- 3 its issue to the office issuing same, shall be punished by a
- 4 fine of not more than ten dollars.
