STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to the Destruction of Fish in East Machias Waters.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. To amend section one of chapter three hun-

- 2 dred and twenty of the special laws of eighteen hundred
- 3 thirty-three, as follows: Strike out the words "under a
- 4 penalty of twenty dollars for every barrel of salmon" and
- 5 insert in lieu thereof, the words 'under a penalty of five
- 6 dollars for every salmon,' so that said section as amended
- 7 shall read as follows:

'Section 1. That, from and after the passing of this 2-2 no person shall be allowed to take any salmon, shad or ale-

3 wives, in the waters of the East Machias river, with a large 4 net, seine, spear or scoop-nets between sunrise on Friday 5 of each week and sunrise on Tuesday of each succeeding 6 week, under a penalty of five dollars for every salmon, of 7 fifteen dollars for every barrel or less quantity of shad; 8 and of five dollars for every barrel or less quantity of aleg wives, so taken.'

Sect. 2. Section eight as amended by chapter one hun-2 dred eighty-six of the special laws of eighteen hundred 3 sixty-seven, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sect. 8. That no person shall take fish of either of the 2 kinds aforesaid on that side of the center of the river on 3 which any fish-way is or may be established within ten rods 4 of the entrance of said fish-way.

It shall be unlawful to take fish of either of the kinds 2 aforesaid on the west side of the center of the said river 3 within twelve rods of the Bangor Hydro-Electric Com-4 pany's dam.

No person, between the fifteenth day of May and the fif2 teenth day of July, shall take any salmon, shad or alewives,
3 in any manner, except by hook and line, in the spillway of
4 the Bangor Hydro-Electric Company's plant on said river
5 within one hundred and thirty feet of the power house of
6 said company, under a penalty of five dollars for every
7 salmon, of fifteen dollars for every barrel or less quantity
8 of shad; and of five dollars for every barrel or less quan9 tity of alewives, so taken.'
