STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Lewis Fitch.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the 2 sum of two hundred dollars to be paid to said Lewis Fitch 3 for damage done to his mill dam by beavers.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Beavers continually damage Mr. Fitch's mill dam, which damage necessitated constant care and removal of refuse from the wheel and gates. Mr. Fitch could get no relief from the Department of Inland Fisheries and Game and was injured in his property for over two years last past by the damage done by said beavers until they were finally removed according to law. The Department of Inland Fisheries and Game notified him that his only redress would be through the present legislature.
