IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, to Reimburse the Town of Eustis for Support of Harold J. Bartlett and Family, Persons Having No Known Settlement in the State.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated to 2 be paid to the town of Eustis, the sum of two hundred 3 eighty-two dollars and nineteen cents, to reimburse said 4 town for money expended for support of Harold J. Bart-5 lett and family, persons having no known settlement in the 6 state.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Harold J. Bartlett and family have had help in the town of Eustis to the amount of \$282.19. There does not appear to be any way of fixing the liability for their support. Mr. Bartlett claims that he was adopted when a small child, but no record of the adoption can be found.
