STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, for Teacher's Pension for Etta M. Patten.

Resolved: That there be paid to Etta M. Patten of Corinna, 2 a pension of two hundred fifty dollars per year, payable 3 quarterly, from the fund appropriated for teachers' pen-4 sions, beginning July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-5 nine, and continuing during the remainder of her life.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

She now receives two hundred dollars per year, but as teachers who receive under the general law, two hundred fifty dollars per annum, it is but fair that she receive the same amount. She is sixty-nine years of age now and is unable to earn a living.
