RESOLVE, in Favor of Isabelle Willett.

Resolved: That there be paid to Isabelle Willett of Lewis-2 ton in the county of Androscoggin and state of Maine, the 3 sum of twelve dollars (\$12.00) per month, payable quarter-4 ly from the fund appropriated for soldiers' pension begin-5 ning January first, nineteen hundred twenty-nine and con-6 tinuing during the pleasure of the legislature.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

The above applicant is the daughter of one George Willett, a private of Captain George I. William Company "I" of the 1st Regiment of Infantry, etc., who was honorably discharged July 25, 1863. Miss Isabelle Willett is about 63 years of age and without means of support and is now located at the "Marcotte Home" in the city of Lewiston.
