RESOLVE, in Favor of Charles W. Huff, Compensating Him for Damages.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the 2 sum of one hundred dollars, to be paid to Charles W. Huff 3 to compensate him for damages done by foxes to his tur-4 keys.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

During the last four years, foxes have killed many of Mr. Huff's turkeys, he estimates his losses to be over five hundred. During the summer of nineteen hundred twenty-eight he lost over forty turkeys which would sell for an average price of six dollars each. He only wishes for reimbursement in part.
