STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Amend Paragraph XVII of Section Six of Chapter One of the Revised Statutes, relating to Rules of Construction; Corporate Seals.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Paragraph XVII of section six of chapter one of the

revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto the

following: 'A seal of a corporation upon a certificate of

stock, corporate bond or other corporate obligation for the

payment of money may be facsimile, engraved or printed,'

so that said paragraph, as amended, shall read as follows:

'XVII. Whenever a corporate seal is used or required

on any instrument, an impression made on the paper

3 of such instrument by the seal of the corporation, without 4 any adhesive substance, shall be deemed a valid seal. A 5 seal of a corporation upon a certificate of stock, corporate 6 bond or other corporate obligation for the payment of 7 money may be facsimile, engraved or printed.'
