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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

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AN ACT Relating to Rules of Construction; Signatures.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Paragraph XX of section six of chapter one of the revised  
2 statutes is hereby amended by striking out all of the second  
3 sentence of said paragraph and substituting in place there-  
4 of the following: 'When the signature of a person is re-  
5 quired, he must write it or make his mark, but the signa-  
6 tures of any officer or officers of a corporation upon a cer-  
7 tificate of shares in such corporation, when any such cer-  
8 tificate is signed by a transfer agent or transfer clerk and  
9 by a registrar, may be facsimiles, engraved or printed,' so  
10 that said paragraph, as amended, shall read as follows:

XX. The words "in writing" and "written" include print-  
2 ing and other modes of making legible words. When the  
3 signature of a person is required, he must write it or make  
4 his mark, but the signatures of any officer or officers of a  
5 corporation upon a certificate of shares in such corporation,  
6 when any such certificate is signed by a transfer agent or  
7 transfer clerk and by a registrar, may be facsimiles, en-  
8 graved or printed.'
