STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Mattawamkeag to Reimburse it for Expenses Incurred and paid by the Town for Care of Emery O. Gooch, a State Highway Police Officer Injured While in Performance of Duty.

Resolved: That there be paid to the town of Mattawam-2 keag the sum of forty-three dollars and sixty cents to reim-3 burse it for expenses incurred and paid by the town to care 4 for Emery O. Gooch, a State Highway Police Officer, who 5 was fatally injured at Mattawamkeag, on August 9th, 1924, 6 while in the performance of his duties of said office.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

On August 9th, 1924, Officer Gooch was thrown from his motorcycle in Mattawamkeag and received injuries rendering him unconscious, from which injuries he later died at the hospital in Bangor. Mattawamkeag employed a local doctor to treat him, and an officer to take Gooch to the Bangor hospital.

The town has not received any reimbursement for this expenditure.
