STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Alfred, for
Reimbursement.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, to
2 be paid to the town of Alfred, for reimbursement for
3 amount expended for the reconstruction of five bridges, the
4 sum of three thousand, seven hundred eighty-eight dollars
5 and eight cents.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

One of these bridges was on a state highway, one on the state aid highway. The bridges were in a dangerous condition so that repairs were very necessary. The state at that time had no funds available.
