STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Regulating Caucuses in the City of Biddeford.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section four of chapter one hundred ninety-nine, private
2 and special laws of one thousand eight hundred ninety-nine,
3 is hereby amended by striking out the word "twenty" in the
4 fourth line thereof, after the word "till," and inserting in
5 place thereof the word 'twenty-five,' so that said section as
6 amended will read as follows:

'Sect. 4. In case the city committee of any political party
2 delays to call a caucus for the nomination of a candidate
3 for such party for the office of mayor, and caucuses for the

4 selection of the various ward candidates till twenty-five days
5 prior to the day of municipal election, such delay shall be
6 deemed such refusal and neglect on the part of such com-
7 mittee as will authorize such caucus and caucuses to be
8 called by a justice of the peace as aforesaid.'
