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Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, to

3 the supplies furnished and services rendered, as undertaker,  
4 in the burial of Joseph Eldridge, of Orneville, the sum of  
5 one hundred nine dollars and eighty-seven cents.

## STATEMENT OF FACTS

Joseph Eldridge was a man of little means. On his decease, the funeral was conducted by Mr. Martin, for which he received no pay.
